



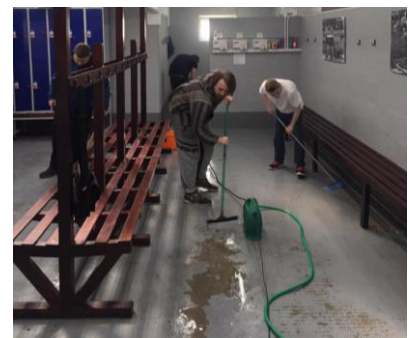
## PRINCE'S TRUST TEAM PROGRAMME TEAM 3

The Youth Commission's Prince's Trust Team Programme began its third 12 week programme in February 2017, helping young people aged 16-25 expand their skill base and ultimately guide them into employment.

The Prince's Trust Team currently has 12 young people on the programme who have spent a week in Wales climbing Pen Y Fan, coasteering at the Blue Lagoon and climbing at Dinas Rock.



They have also recently completed their community project redecorating the Bathing Pool's changing rooms and toilets.



They are currently taking part in two weeks of work experience at organisations such as AFM, St Pierre Park, Ziggurat, Rabeys and Kenny Brouard.

The Prince's Trust helps disadvantaged young people to get their lives on track. It supports 13 to 30 year-olds who are unemployed and those struggling at school and at risk of exclusion. Many of the young people helped by The Prince's Trust in UK are in or leaving care, facing issues such as homelessness or mental health problems, or they have been in trouble with the law. The Trust's programmes give vulnerable young people the practical and financial support needed to stabilise their lives, helping develop self-esteem and skills for work. Three in four young people supported by The Prince's Trust move into work, education or training. The Prince of Wales's charity has helped 825,000 young people since 1976 and supports over 100 more each day.
